

All staff including Clinicians come to work to care for others. Our Practice will not tolerate any form of threatening behaviour, physical or verbal abuse.


Repeat Prescriptions

To allow our doctors and prescription clerks to process your request efficiently, we now require 5 working days to complete any prescription request. Completing a prescription is not an easy task. This involves the dispensary to carefully check your record and the GP doing the same and signing this off in between clinics.

Kindly note that it is your responsibility to ensure you have a sufficient supply of repeat medications. This is especially true during weekends and public holidays. Make sure that you check your medicine supply regularly. You can order your repeat prescription via email, NHS App, AiRMID UK or Systmonline, or through your local pharmacy.

PRACTICE OPENING TIMES

Telephone lines for the Dispensary have been amended. They are open from 10.30 am to 12:30 pm, then 2 pm to 3 pm. The Dispensary hatch is still open from 8:30 am to 1 pm and 2 pm to 5 pm.

Wednesdays – the whole Practice is closed from 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm for staff training. The dispensary opens at 2 pm.
